

# Letter from the Executive Director



In September 2015 Governor Mead signed the Board's new Rules and Regulations into effect. The new rules require a five day notice of intent to drill a newly constructed well or install a pump in a newly constructed well. There has been a lot of calls from licensed contractors questioning the five day requirement. I wanted to let all of you know that the Board will address all of the concerns that contractors have voiced at the next meeting on January 20, 2016. Currently the Board Office is accepting notices from contractors with a very flexible time frame. The Board understands that things change and that contractors cannot always be where they had planned due to unexpected construction complications or weather. I believe at this next meeting the Board will adopt a policy allowing for the flexibility. I will be doing a presentation at the Water Well Convention on the 22nd of January. An update will be given to those in attendance. Until next time! Stay safe.

# **DID YOU KNOW!**

### New study maps Earth's hidden groundwater for the first time!

A new study has, for the first time, estimated the total volume of groundwater present on the Earth. The results show that we're using up the water supply quicker than it can be naturally replaced, while future research will seek to determine exactly how long it will be until modern groundwater runs dry. Groundwater is an extremely precious resource, being a key source of sustenance for humanity and the ecosystems we inhabit. It resides beneath the Earth's surface, ranges from millions of years to just months old, and exists in huge quantities – quite literally millions of cubic kilometers. While calculations back in the 1970s roughly estimated the global volume of groundwater, this new study represents the first detailed calculation of the exact quantity, and it could have big implications.
